

TASK BASED LANGUAGE LEARNING (TBLL)



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Task based language learning strategy focuses on communication through task completion. Students get engaged with a task they are truly interested in and they aim to carry it out only using the target language and its taught elements.

Tasks can include Role plays, conducting an interview, Group discussion, Debate, and presentations. This type of activity will improve the fluency and confidence of the student.

The task based language learning approach is one of many modern ESL teaching methods and focuses on setting a goal for students. This could be a report a presentation etc. During this stage the teacher introduces the task to the students and gets them motivated to perform the given task. Verbal explanations can be supported by some videos so that the student can perform in a better way and understand what to do and what not to do. Once the students have completed the task, it's a good idea to let students evaluate each other's work and finally the teacher can evaluate and give the feedback and award marks based on the performance of the students.
