The Student Induction Programme (SIP) is to conduct to newly admitted undergraduate students for the new stage in their life by facilitating a smooth transition from their home and school environment into the college and university environment. It is one of the mandatory programme in the AICTE Model Curriculum and is to be conducted during the first 3 weeks of the first semester before regular classes begin. It is to be coordinated by Dean, Students in every institution and involve key faculty members, alumni and student volunteers

in delivery. To ensure the implementation of SIP, and in particular to prepare the faculty, AICTE formed a National Coordination Committee for student Induction (NCC-IP).

The UHV-I module of SIP is its core module (there are 7 other modules). To conduct the UHV-1 module effectively, well prepared UHV Faculty (Mentors) are required. The number of UHV Faculty to be prepared is as follows: 1 faculty for every 20 students (Actual intake in 1st Year) in each department of each college.

Objectives of the Programme:

- To understand the role of the human being and the underlying harmony in nature, in existence, to live by it, and to develop an equitable and just society which ensures the wellbeing of all.
- To sensitize the participants about the scope of life – individual, family, society and nature/existence.

Participants' Selection Criteria:

Selection will be done based on first-cum-first serve and the conformed candidates will be notified immediately. The maximum number of participants is 100. The list of selected participants, schedule and other relevant information will be communicated through Whatsapp group.

Criteria to get Certification of Participation:

Please note that AICTE will issue certificates only to those participants who successfully complete the certification criteria. At least 90% attendance in all sessions, completion of all assignments, active participation in all reflections, all quizzes, pre and post workshop survey, self evaluation and submission of all assignments is essential.


